Opportunities in Roma inclusion, human rights and domestic and gender based violence

During the Norway Grants implementation period 2014–2021, the Programme Human Rights supports 8 pre-defined projects and over 40 projects in 8 open calls with activities involved in 3 supported programme areas.

In total, almost 19 million EUR is allocated. The projects will be implemented until April 2024.

Supported areas

Roma Inclusion and Empowerment

This programme area supports projects targeting enhancing the empowerment of Roma, their engagement and integration, especially at a local level. Development of systems for data collection, analysis, monitoring and evaluation for the description of the situation of Roma in the Czech Republic and evaluation of their position are also supported.

The supported projects focus not only on the expansion of the Roma advisors network and creating Roma platforms, but also on the educational aspect, which in turn leads to reducing drop-outs and supports cooperation between schools and families.

Enhanced Support and Competence in Human Rights

The projects, supported by approximately 6,7 million EUR, are implemented in the area related to enhancing capacities and competencies of public institutions (e.g. the Office of Public Defender of Rights), judges and judicial personnel to protect human rights and provide access to justice for minorities, vulnerable and marginalised groups.

Another aim of this programme area is to increase awareness and knowledge of human rights among the public through various awareness campaigns including the national campaign on countering hate, prejudices and stereotypes.

The supported activities include cooperation between educational and academic institutions and other involved entities (civil society, enterprises, etc.), as well as engaging students and young researchers in human rights actions.

Enhanced Capacity of the Prevention System and Fighting Domestic and Gender-based Violence

The aim of this programme area is to enhance prevention of domestic and gender-based violence, and to help and protect the victims.

The supported projects establish centres for the victims of domestic and gender-based violence and/or introduce innovative measures by the providers of specialised services for the victims.

Open calls support projects focused on awareness-raising campaigns on selected topics of domestic and gender-based violence, work with the perpetrators of violence and capacity building of the organisations providing support to the victims of domestic and gender-based violence with the goal of more efficient interdisciplinary cooperation and coordination of services in the field, especially on a regional level.
